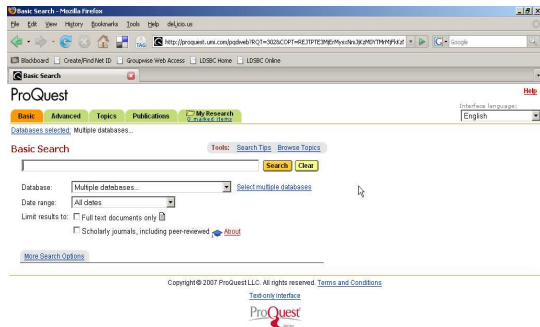

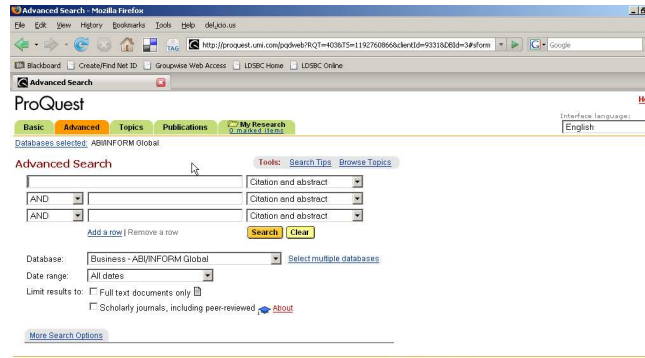


ABI- Inform Business Database

This database is used primarily for finding information on accounting and business topics. The first screen you see when you enter the database is this.

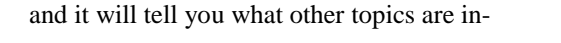
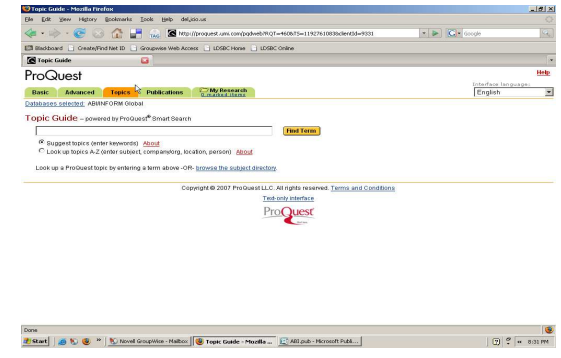


This is the basic search page which allows you to search by keyword or subject but does not give you the option of choosing between the two. If you are looking just for basic information then this kind of search will be sufficient. However, if you want to find more specific information and narrow down your results then you need to use the advanced search which looks like this on the screen.

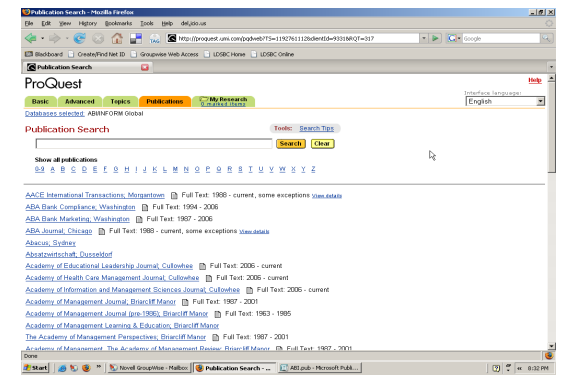


This search option allows you to combine keyword, author, title, journal, subject, document type, language and date options within your search in order to produce more precise results.

An advantage to ABI is that every time you do a search at the top of the results there is a list of additional keywords you may want to include in your search or try in place of your current search. This can help you decide how to best word your search for maximum results.



ABI Inform also has a topic search feature where you can search for information by topic and it will tell you what other topics are in-



cluded in alphabetical order.

Lastly, you can also do a publication search by title or subject or search within one publication.
