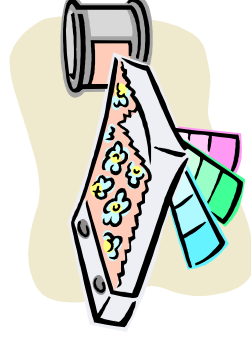
Sullivan-esque: Urban Architecture and Ornamentation/ Schmitt, Ronald E./ Call Number: NA 707.S34x2006
