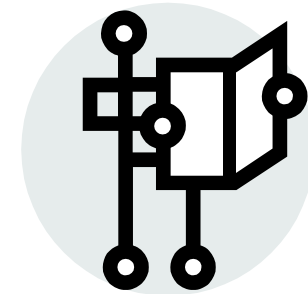

## Databases

### Standard and Poors

This database offers access to company, industry and stock reports as well as much useful information for business students.

### *Business Source Premier*

This is Ebsco's most direct resource for information about specific companies and businesses. Get company reports, stock holder reports and more on all different kinds and sizes of enterprises. Browse or search through Company Profiles, Country Profiles, Industry Reports and Market Research Reports. Search by keyword, company, industry, author, publication and subject.

### *Econ-Lit with full text*

Contains all of the content available in EconLit, plus full text for more than 400 publications including titles from the American Economic Association (all with no embargo), such as: American Economic Review, Journal of Economic Literature, and Journal of Economic Perspectives. This database also contains many non-English full-text journals in economics & finance.



## Ebooks

The Library has access to over 300,000 ebooks. These include ebooks on every subject imaginable. Many of these are business oriented and there are ebooks on popular topics such as Ebay, developing a business plan, marketing, sales and entrepreneurship as well as the dummies series.
