▶ Net Library-What is it? and How do you use it?

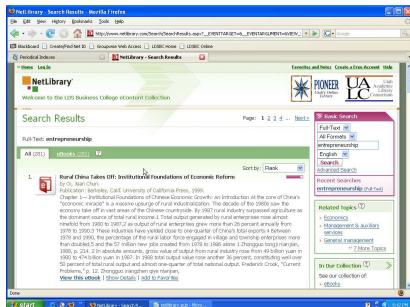


Net Library

Net Library is a database like program that our library subscribes to which allows you to access thousands of books online which we do not have physically available.

You can search according to full text, keyword, title, author, or subject.

For example I typed in the full text search term: Entrepreneurship.



This pulls up quite a few results but the one I want to look at is the second one.

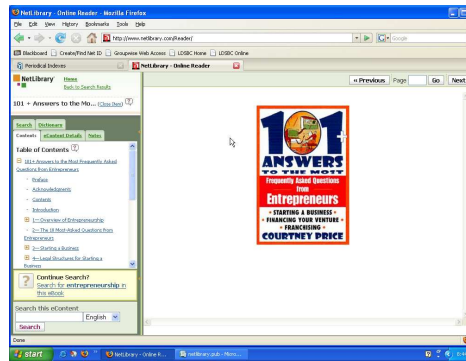
I am given the options of

I see a picture of the cover with some search and viewing options in the left hand column.

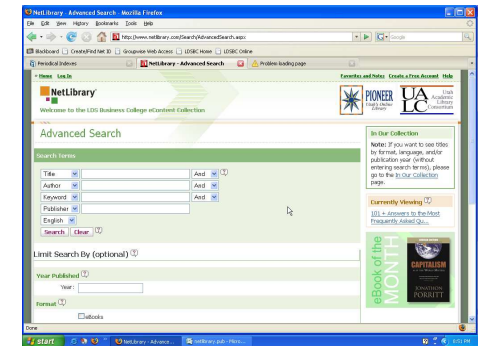
I can click on the titles of each of the chapters and view them on screen in the big box to the right.

There is also a dictionary feature where I can search different terms.

It is also possible to do an advanced search as shown here:



There are several search options given. You can search by subject, keyword, author, title, publisher, full text, isbn number, and full text as well as combinations of these terms.

You can also search by year published.

Likewise, if you click on the in our collection page, you can browse the titles available.
